Fire Protection (Union Fire Contracts)	-	1 st highest
Government Administration Expenditures (govt. staff costs)	-	5 th highest
Outstanding Debt	-	5 th highest
Insurance Trust Expenditures (administering public pensions)	-	3 th highest

Our State government spends an incredible amount of our tax dollars. What are we getting for our tax payments? Here is how we rank in those categories where we actually want RI to be at the top of the list:

Rhode Island Per Capita Expenditure Rankings out of 50 States

Higher Education Expenditures	-	47 th lowest
Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation Expenditures	-	49 th lowest
Highway Expenditures	-	49 th lowest
State Business Climate	-	44 th lowest
Unemployment rate	-	11.9%
